First BH Circuit, international photography contest, is now open for photography lovers from all over the world! Send us your best photographs, closing date is 2 November 2008.

The Circuit will be shown in Sarajevo, Mostar and Banja Luka. There will be only one judging session and same set of photographs will be shown in each city. The decision of the jury is final and irrevocable. The entries per section will be presented to the jury consecutively. An author can only win one award per section.

The competition will consist of two sections:

- **General**
- **Special for 2008: Colours of the Fall**

Entries **must** originate as photographs (image-captures of objects via light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally. Photographs taken by mobile phone will not be accepted. By submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his/hers own and permits the organizers to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for advertising the BH Circuit. The exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright. This exhibition is open to everyone; however, an entry may be rejected if organizers or jury believes the entry does not conform to exhibition rules and conditions.

Digital files: Only digital files in jpg format will be accepted on CD-ROM. Each author can enter maximum of 4 digital files for each theme (total of 8 digital files can be entered – colour, monochrome or mixed).

A folder called 'LOW' should contain low-resolution images (72 dpi, maximum size 1024 pixels, jpeg format, compression 8) for judging, while a folder called 'HIGH' should contain the same images in a high resolution (300 dpi, minimum size 2400 pixels, jpeg format, compression 12) for the projection and catalogue. CD-ROM's will not be returned. Files on the CD-ROM should be named as follows:

BA-Benne-G-0632-A1.jpg

- **BA** = ISO 3166 country code for Bosnia and Herzegovina
- **Gordon Bennett** = author's name and surname
- **Benne** = the first five (5) letters of author's surname
- **G** = the first character (initial) of your given name
- **0632** = the last four (4) digits of your phone number (+ 387 69 980 632)
- **A1 – A4.jpg** = the section letter **A** (General) and image number **(1-4)** of the entry.
- **B1 – B4.jpg** = the section letter **B** (Colours of the Fall) and image number **(1-4)** of the entry.

You will fill in the corresponding original titles at the entry form. The entry form can be downloaded from www.grupaf8.com and should be printed and signed by author.

Club entries on CD: On a CD should be a separate folder for each member, which carries the same name as the participant. Please note: all club entries shall be presented on one joint CD/DVD, do not enter club entries on single CD's for each entrant. All entrants must fill in the entry form for each section entered.

Entry fee: Each participant pays the appropriate entry fee of 5€ or 10KM per section in bank notes. Photographs sent without an entry fee will not enter the competition.

Each of the four judges will assign 1 to 10 points to each image, therefore the sum of points assigned by all judges will determine which images will be accepted. Maximum points per image will be 40. For public multimedia presentation we are planning to accept up to 250 works in both sections.
